The power supply has voltage instability: If incoming line voltage fluctuates or spikes, it can push the DC bus beyond its design limits. There's a mismatch in load inertia: A high-inertia load that keeps spinning after the drive commands a stop will regenerate more power than the system can. Cause : Overvoltage comes when voltage in the DC bus has exceeded the overvoltage detection level. If it overshoots or brakes, the DC link will increase until you reach the tripping voltage somewhere close to 1200 V for a 600 V drive.
