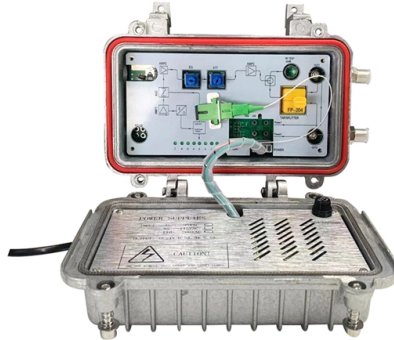


Can an optocoupler be short-circuited



Overview

The output of the opto-coupler is NOT short-circuit proof, in that if the relay coil is shorted or draws too much current the opto transistor will blow. The series resistor determines the LED current. I want to use an NPN optocoupler (ACPL-214) to drive an offboard relay.
