Industry standards often recommend at least 300mm (12 inches) of spacing between power and control trays to minimize EMI. When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. This spacing is crucial for adequate maintenance access, ease of inspection, and ensuring proper airflow for effective heat dissipation. It also helps reduce the risk of. Some outdoor cable tray installations may have to span anywhere from 20 to 40-feet to cross roads. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray cont d for instrumentation and control applications that require.
