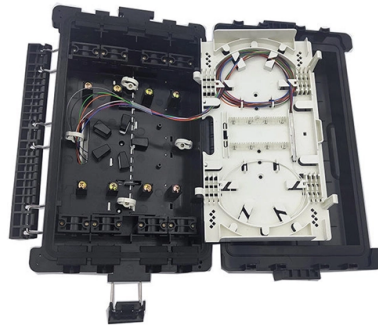


Function of the protective wire in the distribution box
