For general application, rods must be at least 8 feet long and 3/8 inch in diameter, according to National Electrical Code® (NEC) Section 250. Longer or multiple rods are often needed in drier locations where the soil is less conductive. Proper grounding and bonding are critical for creating an effective fault-current path, protecting both people and equipment. The entire assembly forms a key part of the grounding electrode system, which works to stabilize voltage and. A ground rod, also known as an earthing rod, grounding rod or ground electrode, is a long, slender metal rod that is typically made of materials like copper or steel. It is buried in the ground and electrically bonded to the main service panel. During fault conditions, low impedance results in high fault current flow, causing overcurrent protective.
