

How to connect fiber optic cables to road surveillance cameras



Overview

Most cameras feature an RJ45 port and a twisted pair-to-fiber optic media converter must be used. The media converter connects directly to a fiber-enabled network switch via fiber optic cable and matching SFP transceiver modules. Using fiber optic cables offers numerous benefits that make them a better choice for security camera systems: 1. High Bandwidth: Fiber optic cables are capable of supporting data speeds up to 10Gbps or beyond and they carry large amounts of data over extended distances without compromising on video. A fiber optic solution is far simpler, economical, and allows for greater distances between switches when designing and deploying a network to install IP cameras. You can combine PoE switches with available fiber optic uplink connections together to form a heterogeneous system that takes advantage. In this video, we walk you through a real-world IP camera installation project that involves setting up a network for 10+ cameras across a 150-meter distance between a garage and a control room.
