Using a regular jumper / launch cable connecting the otdr to the desired port you're troubleshooting. Then once you hit the field you have something called an optical fiber identifier (OFI) to find the tone by testing loose. The fiber color code is a standardized method that assigns specific colors to fiber optic components—including outer cable jackets, individual fiber strands, and connectors—to ensure reliable identification throughout installation and maintenance. These printings are critical in identifying the cable's type, performance, and compliance with industry standards. These cables are used mainly for digital audio connections between devices.
